Method of Computation of Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA): The SGPA is the ratio of sum of the product of the number of credits with the grade points scored by a student in all the courses taken by a student and the sum of the number of credits of all the courses undergone by a student, i.e.

$$SGPA (S_i) = \frac{\sum (C_i \times G_i)}{\sum C_i}$$

Where C_i is the number of credits of the course and G_i is the grade point scored by the student in the course.

Grading Pattern: Postgraduate Program

The University follows relative grading of students. The students are evaluated on a quality point from **0 to 10** as well as classified into letter grade from F to O. The equivalence of quality point and letter grade is as follows:
